On September 7, 2010, the Federal Election Commission notified you of a complaint filed against Sager for Congress and you, as treasurer, alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("Act"). On April 7, 2011 based upon the information contained in the complaint, and information provided by you, the Commission decided to dismiss the complaint and closed its file in this matter.


